Class Title/Fee	Pre-Requisite	Description	Class Duration
Agility Classes			
Agility 101 \$ 100	Dog must be at least 3 months old.	The class will include some basic obedience skills that we feel are required to be successful on an agility course. This class is designed to aid you and your new agility teammate to build a strong working relationship! We will work on creating a strong play drive. You and your dog will be exposed to “operant conditioning”. To help aid your dog on focus training, we will play “crate games”. We will also introduce your dog to end contacts and agility groundwork.	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Intro to Agility \$ 100	Acquired the skills in Agility 101.	The dog/handlers teams will be exposed to all agility equipment and will continue to work on the progression of “contact training”. We will begin some initial “sequencing” of jumps/obstacles.	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Advanced Agility \$ 125	Acquired the skills in Intro to Agility.	The dog/handlers teams will be expected to be completing all contact obstacles and weave poles successfully. We will continue to work on sequencing and advanced skills.	8 weeks 1 1/2 hours per week
Competition Agility \$ 125	Acquired the skills in Advanced Agility.	The dog/handler teams will be working on competition level course work and distance skills. These handler dog teams should be competing and working on their own individual agility goals, titles, etc.	8 weeks 1 1/2 hours per week
Obedience Classes			
Rally \$90		Rally is a fun way to break into the competition world with little or not pressure. In this class we will discuss each sign at every level and learn how to properly negotiate a Rally course. This class is for all levels of Rally.	8 hours 1 hour per week
Junior Jump Start \$90	For dogs older than 6 months of age.	This class is geared toward the junior handler. Children ages 8 through 13 will cover basic obedience skills, with their canine companion. This program will help the dog and handler strengthen their relationship and explore other dog sports available to them along the way!	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Puppy Pre-School \$90	For dogs 12 weeks to 6 months of age.	Class will focus on socialization with humans and other canines. We will start with basic manners to get your puppy started right! There will be discussions on different aspects involved with owning a puppy and how to successfully raise a well-rounded canine. This class will help you learn the concept of training; preparing you and your puppy for additional classes offered here at Greta’s Gym!	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Primary School \$90	For dogs older than 6 months of age.	Class will cover the basic commands such as: sit, down, stay and come. Dogs will learn to walk on a lead, as well as work on household manners and everyday good behavior. Each week we will have a different confidence builder, to help the dogs learn, trust and boost their self confidence. Commands are taught in a way that solidifies the behaviors so the dog can consistently achieve success. Building a solid foundation within this class will make future training easier.	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Secondary School \$90	Demonstrated ability of Primary School skills	We will work toward quicker response times to commands and longer duration for stay command. We will continue to build confidence in your dog and your relationship will become stronger.	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Competition Level 1: “Novice” \$ 100	Demonstrated ability of Primary School skills	For the dog/handler team truly serious about obedience in the competition ring. If you and your dog can achieve all of the skills taught during these eight weeks, you will be ready to start competing for titles in the lower levels of competition obedience, in all venues.	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Competition Level 2: “Open” \$ 100	Demonstrated ability of Competition Level 1—“Novice” skills	For the dog/handler team ready to start the more complicated exercises, which teach your dog to do a variety of tasks and to follow commands either by voice or signal. The skills mastered in this class will allow you to start competing in the Intermediate Level (Open Class) of Obedience Competition, in all venues.	8 weeks 1 hour per week
Competition Level 3: “Utility” \$ 100	Demonstrated ability of Competition Level 2—“Open” skills	This class is to help dog/handler teams to compete in the highest level of obedience competition. This is a very challenging class and will prepare you and your dog to earn titles in the highest level of any obedience venue!	8 weeks 1 hour per week



Please note: Our training programs are “skills based”. This means that you and your dog must have the skills required in order to advance to the next level. Just because you have been “in a class” does not gain you access to the next level.
