



**Steps to Enroll Your Dog in
GRETA'S DAYTIME PLAYTIME**

Greta's Daytime Playtime will be a very unique environment that most dogs have yet to experience. Because your dog will be interacting with many dogs while attending our Daytime Playtime, it is important that we closely screen each and every dog before they are allowed to participate. Therefore, before attending, all dogs must first pass our Temperament Evaluation. Before taking the Temperament Evaluation and becoming a member of Greta's Daytime Playtime, the following steps need to be taken:

1. Dogs must be at least 12 weeks of age.
2. Dogs over 7 months of age must be spayed or neutered.
3. Contact your veterinarian and ask them to fax or email your dog's records to us. The items in **red** are not required to attend Greta's Daytime Playtime but are recommended.

Puppy:	
8 weeks	DHP-PV, Frontline (or other monthly flea/tick preventative)
12 weeks	DHP-PV, Bordetella* (at least 10 days prior to attending Greta's Daytime Playtime), Lymes
16 weeks	DHP-PV, Rabies
1 year	DHP-PV, Rabies, Fecal – clear
Dog:	
	DHP-PV – annual Bordetella* – annual (at least 10 days prior to attending Greta's Daytime Playtime) Fecal – clear – annual Frontline (or other monthly flea/tick preventative) – April 15 to October 15 Rabies – three (3) years Lymes Heartworm test and Heartgard preventative

*Bordetella: Can be administered two ways: intranasal or injection. If administered intranasally, it should be administered annually. If injected, puppy needs it at 12 weeks and at 16 weeks and annually thereafter.

The records indicating proof of above need to be faxed to 218-748-6788 or emailed to info@gretasgym.com **PRIOR TO** the Temperament Evaluation. Owners will also need to provide updated information annually.

3. Complete the Enrollment Application. (This form is available on our website: www.gretasgym.com.)
4. Set a date and time for your dog's Temperament Evaluation with our Daytime Playtime staff.
5. When you arrive at Greta's Daytime Playtime for the Temperament Evaluation, you should plan to remain with your dog for at least 20 minutes. All dogs should be under control on a leash. At this point we will review both your dog's vet records and Enrollment Application. Incomplete records will prevent your dog from being able to stay, so be sure to have all appropriate records upon arriving or call to check that we have received the records from your vet.
6. While you are present, we will conduct a Pre-Temperament Evaluation. This ensures us that your dog will be comfortable with us handling him/her after you are gone.
7. At this point, you will pay \$37.50 for the Temperament Evaluation. You may now leave.
8. During this period, your dog will be assessed by our trained staff following a protocol established for testing the temperament of dogs. Your dog should remain for a minimum of 3 hours. If your dog does well, he/she will start to be introduced to some of our other dogs. If, at any time, your dog appears to **not** have the appropriate temperament for our Daytime Playtime program, we will stop the evaluation and your dog will be kept for the remainder of the day separated from the other dogs. (Last pickup is 6 p.m.) You will be provided with a Temperament Evaluation report.
9. Should your dog do well, we will continue to acquaint him/her with our Daytime Playtime program. Your dog may stay for the remainder of the day. (Last pickup is 6 p.m.) You will be provided with a Temperament Evaluation report. CONGRATULATIONS! At this point your dog will be an official member of Greta's Daytime Playtime! You are now invited to bring your dog to Greta's Daytime Playtime whenever you wish!
